OSSMA Uniform Guidance

Why is Uniform important at OSSMA?

OSSMA's uniform is designed to ensure that students look smart and feel that they are part of our academy's community. We are committed to ensure that uniform is affordable to all students.

Essential Uniform Items

Black blazer – OSSMA Black Academy Blazer

Shirt - Plain white formal school shirt (Long or short sleeves).

Tie - OSSMA academy tie (must have no graffiti)

Black skirt – Black knee length pleated school skirt from any school provider. Must be 20 inch in length. Material **MUST** be the same as a blazer (no Lycra tube skirts or jersey style miniskirts)

Trousers - Black school trousers from any school wear provider, no skinny/Lycra/leggings, or any jean-style trousers whether in denim or any other material. Material must be the same as a blazer. No cropped trousers or turned up trousers.

Shoes - Black school shoes (not canvas, sports branded, boots or trainers). See additional visual. Boots may be worn travelling to school in bad weather, however, shoes must be brought to wear in school

Socks – Need to be black. Socks should be above the ankle meeting the bottom of the trousers. **No trainer socks.**

Black tights -(80 - 100 denier).



Coat - Plain and waterproof, no jackets, hoodies, leather, camouflage pattern or denim jackets allowed. Tracksuit/hooded leisure tops are not acceptable and will be confiscated if seen.

Religious Clothing - Hijabs must be secure and must be black.

Bag - School bag large enough to fit all coursework books (at least A4 in size), equipment and PE Kit.

Optional Uniform Items

Jumper - (Optional) Plain black V neck plain jumper. No sweatshirts/round neck sweaters. No logos.

Essential PE Items

T-Shirt – OSSMA Polo Shirt with OSSMA Logo
Jogging bottoms or shorts – Black with no lines, branding, or logos
Leggings – Black with no lines, branding, or logos
Footwear – Trainers – no canvas pump style

Optional PE Items

Rugby Top - OSSMA Rugby Top with OSSMA logo

Black skin or jumper – For under their PE tops when it is cold.

Footwear – Moulded Football Boots for activities on the 3G pitch. No blades or studs allowed. Any boots can be used for activities on the grass.

Questions regarding Uniform

Can pupils wear jewellery?

- Only one pair of stud earrings can be worn in the lower lobe. No other piercings allowed anywhere, including
 tongues, tragus, eyebrows, lips, nose, upper ear. We advise all students not to have piercings until the start
 of the 6-week holidays to ensure all studs can be safely removed prior to the start of the school year. Clear
 studs / retainers cannot be worn. Plasters covering any piercing are not allowed.
- A watch is permitted. Smart watches can be worn but must have all notifications silenced or they will be confiscated as per mobile phone policy.
- No other jewellery is allowed e.g. rings/ bracelets/bangles cannot be worn.

Any jewellery confiscated will be put in an envelope and can be collected at the main reception at the end of the day.

Can pupils wear Make up?

We ask that students only wear a small amount of natural looking make up. Where students arrive at school with excessive make up, heavily contoured foundation and highlighters, bright eyeliner, lipstick, coloured lip glosses, nail varnish etc, they will be asked to remove it.

Can pupils have cosmetics?

Nail varnish, false eyelashes, false nails, including acrylic, builder gel, gel overlays and shellac are not acceptable.

What about hair styles and colour?

Hair must be natural colours only and neat in appearance. Decorative hairpieces are not acceptable. Any braids should be a natural hair colour.

No lines, designs cut into hair or eyebrows.

Grade 1 and above and skin fades are allowed. No extreme hairstyles (the academy reserves the right to make a final decision if necessary).

Can pupils have tattoos?

Any tattoos should not be visible and should always remain covered. Henna tattoos are not allowed other than during Religious Observations.

Can pupils wear headwear other than for religious reasons?

No, Students are not allowed to wear baseball caps, hats, durags or a bandana in the academy.

Are pupils allowed to have a mobile phone?

No, mobile phones are forbidden within the school grounds. Mobile phones will be confiscated if students have them out in class, during social times or in any areas of the school premises. They will be placed in an envelope and will need to be collected from the front office by parents/carers up until 4:30 p.m each day.

Are Air Pods / wireless headphones allowed?

No, neither item is allowed anywhere in the academy building, including in lessons, around the corridors or on the yards. If either are seen they will be confiscated, placed in an envelope, and taken to main reception where they can be collected by the student at the end of the day.

NOTES

Students with dispensation regarding an agreement to wear a differentiated uniform in keeping with OSSMA standards, e.g. boots or trainers must be non-branded plain black.

For students to be allowed any dispensation they will require medical evidence each academic year. This should be given to the student's Head of Year and will be reviewed each half term.

Parents should be aware that any student arriving at the academy wearing the incorrect uniform can expect to be sent to our Inclusion Hub and will be isolated until the parent/carer can bring the correct uniform. We have spare uniform which students can access each day.

The decision regarding the appropriateness of the above areas of appearance is at the discretion of the OSSMA Pastoral Team.

Students can be challenged by any member of staff regarding suitability of uniform. This will be done at line-ups in a morning and throughout the day.

The academy does not accept any responsibility for the loss of or damage to personal possessions brought on site.
